Cow Share Testing Program and Health Warning

All milk produced by Windsor Dairy LLC by contract to Shareowners is not pasteurized. Unpasteurized milk may contain pathogens that are a health risk to all consumers. Pregnant women, young children and infants and elderly people as well as immune compromised people (patients undergoing chemotherapy, immunosuppressive treatment or with clinical HIV) may be at increased risk of certain milk borne diseases. These diseases include Brucellosis, Tuberculosis, Campylobacteriosis, Listeriosis, Salmonellosis, diseases associated with E. coli infections and other rarer diseases.

Windsor Dairy LLC tests cows for:

Tuberculosis - skin test every 3 years. Staphylococcus aureus - periodic milk culture . Mycobacterium paratuberculosis (Johne's Disease) - blood test once. Milk nutrient composition-monthly milk sample. Somatic cell count - monthly milk sample. Clinical mastitis - visual at each milking.

Windsor Dairy LLC tests bulk milk for::

Brucellosis with annual milk ring test.

Listeria, E coli 0157, Salmonella, and Campylobacter at a certified food safety lab periodically.

Herd Health:

A high forage diet including properly fermented forages and clean pasture/housing and milking procedures reduce the risk of bacterial contamination of milk.

The facility leased by Windsor Dairy LLC for use in milk harvesting is a Grade A capable milking facility operated by veterinarians. Windsor Dairy LLC requests that all shareowners visit the farm to look at cows, meet the farmers, and observe milking procedures prior to signing a contract.
